There are two broad primary categories that comprise social science research. These are the Quantitative and Qualitative Design Methods. The methods used in the Quantitative Design category most often rely on statistical analysis, such as the analysis of numerical data to establish a hypothesis that is provable by mathematical or statistical means.
