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Vasiee et al. (2016) recognized *Bacillus cereus* as the best lipase-producing bacteria of all isolates studied. The extracellular lipase of *Bacillus subtilis* (Ma et al. 2018) was reported. Additionally, Aboulwafa et al. (2016) reported that *B. thuringiensis* is a strong producer ( $P_z = 0.49$  in the current study).

These bacteria have a generation time of about 20 h, thus isolation and identification may take up to 6 weeks (although a few species may grow in only 5–7 days). These bacteria are acid-alcohol-fast, which means that after staining they resist decolorization with acidified alcohol as well as strong mineral acids.

Acinetobacter baumannii complex is a Gram-negative coccobacillus that is

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oxidase-negative, indole negative, catalase positive, and exhibits twitching motility in wet mount, though it is nonmotile in motility agar. It is a non-fermenter on MacConkey agar but some strains are partial lactose-fermenters. It is a soil bacterium that causes rare infections in humans, and is often multi-drug-resistant.

A 10-day-old girl with a history of postasphyxia acute renal failure,

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which recovered within 7 days, was given teicoplanin for sepsis due to *Staphylococcus hominis* [68]. The dosage used was erroneously high (20 mg/kg 12-hourly instead of an initial dose of 16 mg/kg followed by 6–8 mg/kg/day), and therapy was suspended after 5 days. She improved, and blood cultures were negative.
