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Sashiko thread is made of sturdy, heavy-weight cotton, and usually available in 20-meter skeins. Embroidery floss can be a suitable substitute-the difference being its sheen quality and the looser strands that can be singled out for thinner stitches; as such, the look and feel of the stitching will be slightly different.

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fabric. For better visualizing, it's helpful to get out some graph paper and sketch out your design. Don't forget to include any seam allowances (for pillows), hemming (for tailored pants), edging (for canvas wall-art) or additional fabric you might need for gathering, crimping, and smocking.

Fabric cufflinks. An alternative type of cufflink is the cheaper silk knot which is usually two conjoined monkey's fist or Turk's head knots. The Paris shirtmaker Charvet is credited with their introduction in 1904. They became quickly popular: "Charvet [link] buttons of twisted braid are quite the style" noted The New York Times in 1908.

This DIY lampshade project took inspiration from an embroidered pillow that had two intertwined pieces of cording. To replicate that look, a piece of white cord was hot-

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glued to linen fabric, then that fabric was glued to the lampshade. It's much easier to lay down the cording on a flat surface than to try to glue it directly to the lampshade.
